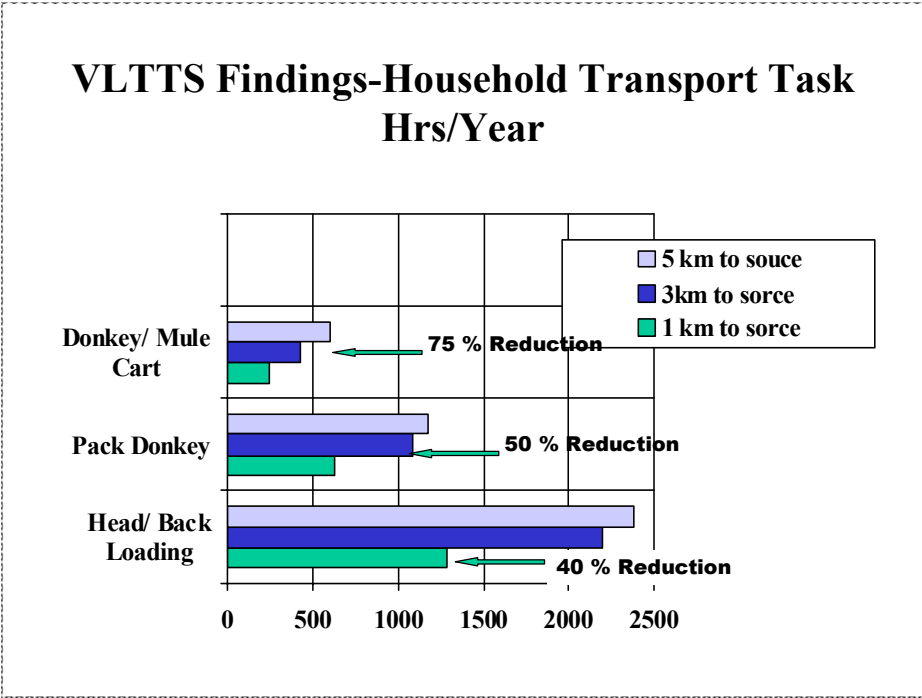
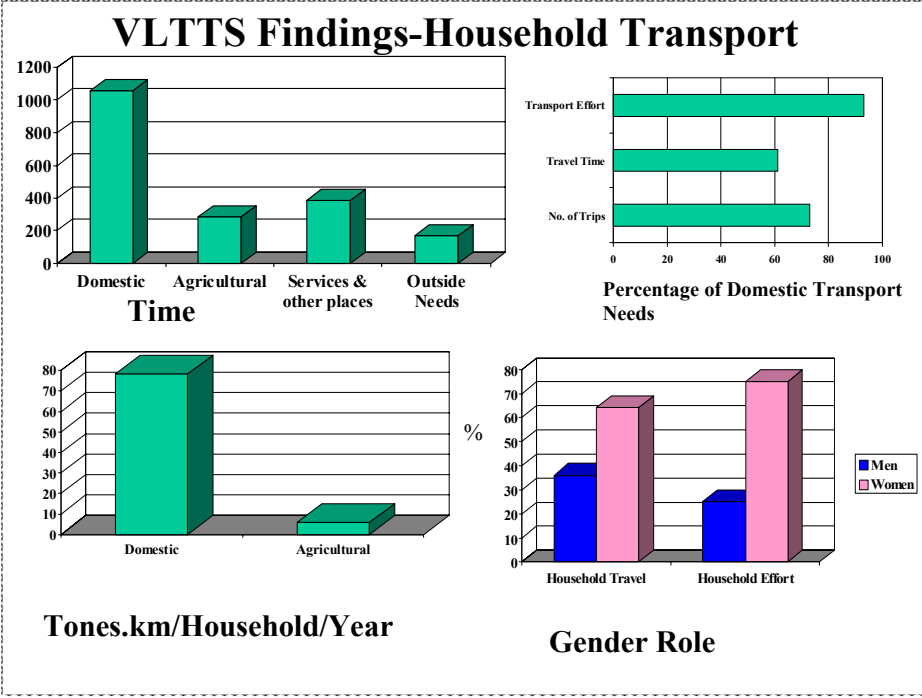


Overview of RSDP - Objectives

RRTS- Workshop Recommendations

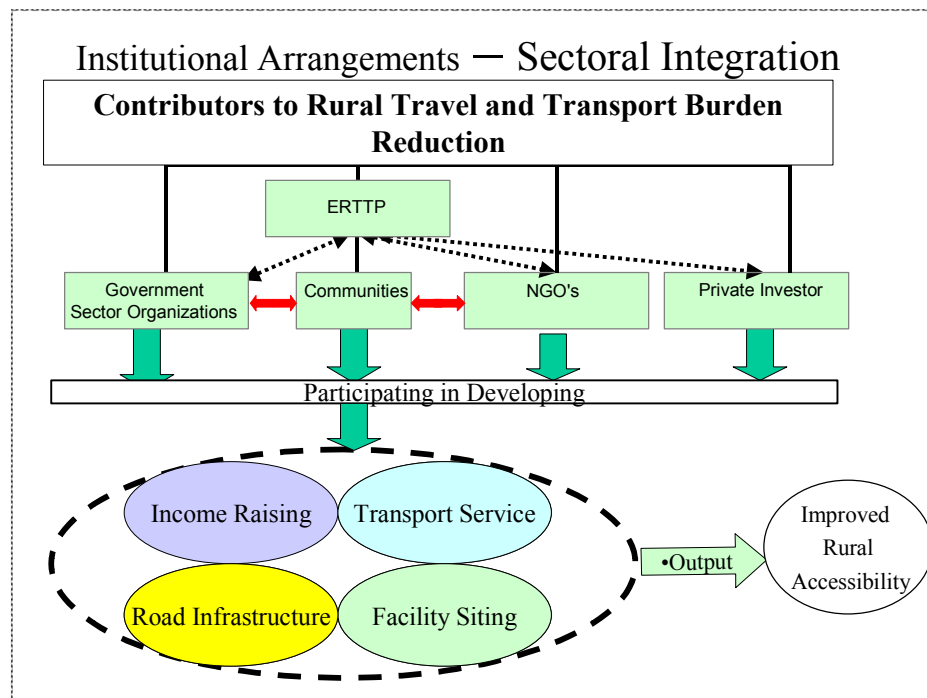
- To Establish an institutional structure for ERTTP

- To promote the development of non-transport intervention measures

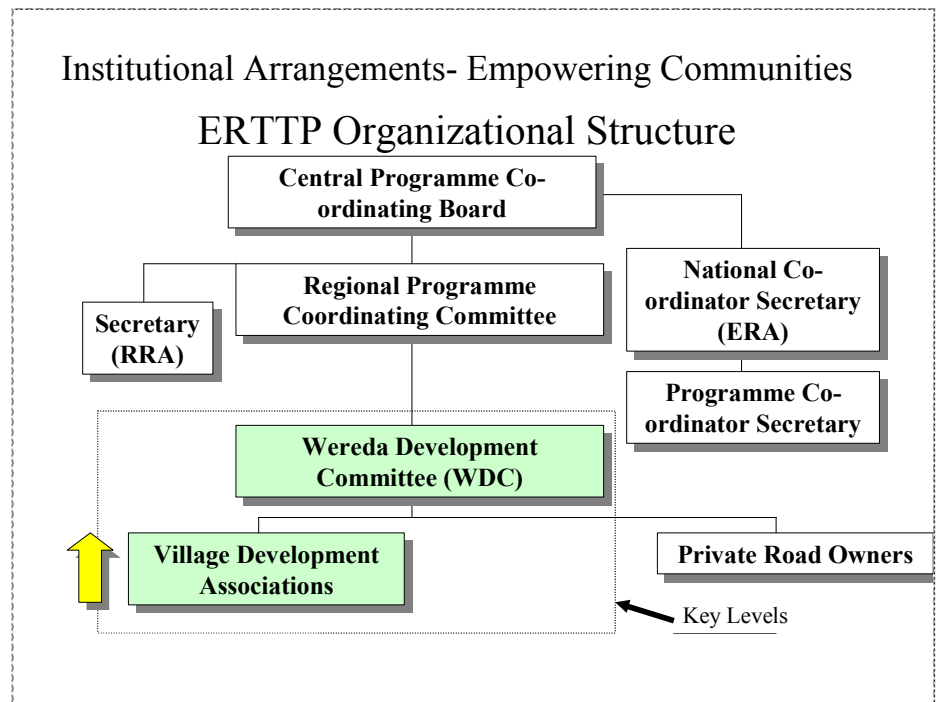
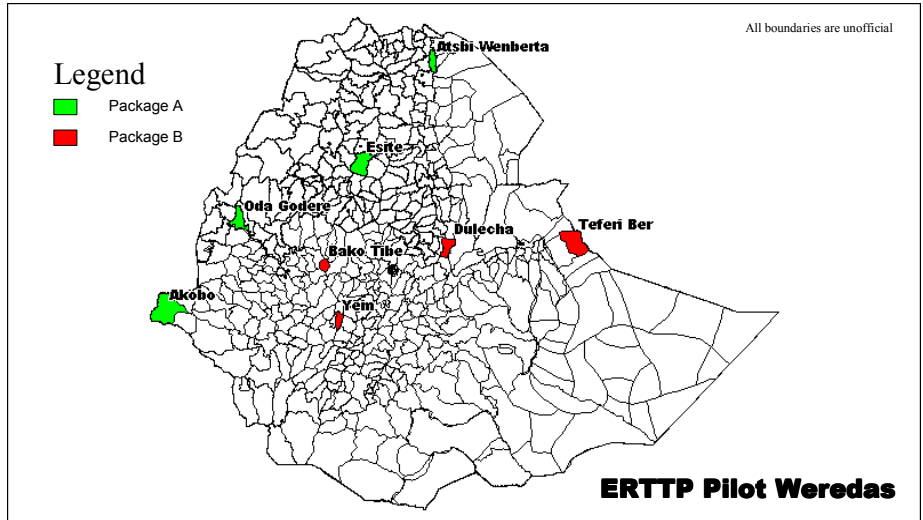
